## **Harlem United awarded a TD Banknorth Charitable Foundation Grant for E-Supportive Housing Initiative**

New York, NY (November 6, 2008) – On October 20, 2008, TD Banknorth Charitable Foundation announced \$25,000 in funding for the E-Supportive Housing Initiative, which was awarded to Harlem United Community AIDS Center, one of four awardees in the New York metro area out of a total of eighty-nine applicants. The E-Supportive Housing Initiative is a technologically-based and replicable non-profit supportive housing solution. The award will help fund property management software and training that will help improve management, tracking and analysis of client data, such as rent payments, maintenance requests, and most importantly, health outcomes of 485 Harlem United housing clients.
